

Intellectual Property Rights Statement

Rocky Mountain Infection Control Association (RMICA) is a non-profit organization and will not make commercial use of the content in the handouts and speaker-provided materials provided to attendees at RMICA-sponsored educational programs. RMICA's sole objective making the speaker-provided handouts and materials available to attendees is to benefit attendee's professional educational needs.

RMICA recognizes both the importance of respecting the speaker's intellectual property rights and the needs of the infection prevention and control community to have access to speaker handouts and material for use in the attendee's professional education and for the attendee's infection prevention and control program and curriculum development.

RMICA acknowledges that speakers have a right to decline to provide handouts for their presentation(s). Handouts or material provided or referenced by the speaker in the public domain (e.g., CDC, OSHA, etc) and freeware are not copyrighted and may be freely duplicated and used for non-commercial purposes by the attendee.
